The Motorcycle Diaries (2004)

"The Motorcycle Diaries" is based on the journals of Che Guevara, leader of the Cuban Revolution. In his memoirs, Guevara recounts adventures he, and best friend Alberto Granado, had while crossing South America by motorcycle in the early 1950s.

Biography of Mario Vargas Llosa (2004)

This biography tells the story of one of Latin America's most renowned and acclaimed writers: Mario Vargas Llosa. It is a truthful and compelling piece that will unveil incredible revelations and stories of an extraordinary artist.

What the Eye Doesn't See (Ojos que no ven) (2003)

The film ties six stories during the days when the "vladivideos" (tapes where Vladimiro Montesinos, the Peruvian's president councillor, is recorded while he was buying opposite politics) have appeared causing the fall of Fujimori's government in Peru.

Django: la otra cara (2002)

A Peruvian film that tells the story of the bank robberies' legend, Orlando González best known as Django. This movie shows the intense life of this character; not only focusing in the robberies, but also in the reasons that pushed him into acting the way he did.

Bala perdida (2001)

The Elusive Good (also known as The Good Bastard and Bien esquivo, El) (2001)

Aguirre, der Zorn Gottes (1972)

A few decades after the destruction of the Inca empire, a Spanish expedition leaves the mountains of Peru and goes down the Amazon river in search of gold and wealth.

Anthropology: A Study of People (1970)

The Spanish Conquistadores wrote the history of Peru's ancient civilizations, as told to them by the Inca. But archaeologists found evidence that this "history" is false. Great cultures developed in South America long before the Inca.
